MEGA CHURCH REOPENING GUIDELINES

The Leadership of Mega Church has been working hard to ensure that our church is safe and abiding by the recommendations of the CDC as we reopen for weekly worship services. We ask that you review the following information as you prepare to worship with us. It is our goal that everyone remains safe as we come back together, and while you may desire to be back with us, we ask that you please refrain from coming to worship if you experience any of the following:

- Fever (Temp of 100.0 F)
- Cough or respiratory symptoms
- Being with anyone that has recently been diagnosed with COVID 19 without wearing a mask.
- Recently traveled to a high-risk area with increased COVID 19 outbreaks

What should you expect as you come to Mega for worship services?

- We will be directing the entrance to and exit from the church to designated areas to decrease any large gathering of people as you enter and exit the church.
- There will be screenings as you enter and exit the church.
 - Screenings will consist of temperature checks as well as a screening questions. If there are any concerns, you will be asked to refrain from attending worship in person that day.
- There will be hand sanitizing stations in the church that will allow for sanitizing your hands as you enter and exit the sanctuary.
- We will be practicing physical distancing. With this, you will see that there may be rows/spots that are blocked off. A family is asked to sit together without having 6 feet between each person.
- We request that all in attendance wear a mask. While we recognize that you also have a right to refrain from wearing one, we will have a designated area for those with no mask to be seated.
 - Based upon CDC recommendations, masks are only needed for children over the age of 2. It is at the parents' discretion to use a mask and if you would like your children to attend service.
- At this time, we have made the decision to not have Children's Church. All children are expected to sit with their parents during any service.
- We also ask that the number of those in the restroom be limited to two people at a time.
- The water fountain will be turned off and not available during worship services.
- There will be no food or drink services available at this time. Any food consumption will need to take place in the fellowship hall.
- All Transportation Ministry services have been suspended until further notice, as provision of services would require additional safety measures. Changes will be made as we continue to monitor state and government information.

The following additional measures have been established to help maintain safety for our members as well as those that choose to come visit with us.

- The sanctuary and classrooms will be frequently cleaned.
- Everyone is to exit the sanctuary immediately between services so the facility can be sanitized in preparation for the next service.
- Please be patient at the end of services. Do NOT exit the sanctuary on your own accord; however, follow the directions of the Mega Church Doorkeepers as dismissal protocols have been established. Seniors and those with any physical disabilities will be dismissed first.
- Everyone is to exit the building and have conversations outside of the church building.

While we recognize that all of these changes will be new to us as a worshipping body, these are steps that will assist in keeping everyone safe. We will continue to monitor any updates that will help determine if any changes are needed to our current reopening plan. We recognize that there will be some that are unable or choose not to return to worship services at this time.
